"Time to stop this war, I'm too tired", Mwita Mataro sings, underlined by the unmistakable cool and noisy sound of At Pavillon, four romantic rebels in neat shirts and with smooth, heart wrenching rhythms. In June 2018, the indie-pop band released their single "Stop This War" (Las Vegas Records), sending a pretty clear message to the world. They are now about to release their newest trick "Lions" and - with summer festivals like United Islands of Prague (CZ) and FM4 Frequency Festival (AT) under their belt - will kick off their fall tour at Reeperbahn Festival 2018.

Founded in 2010, At Pavillon move beyond the typical rock sounds and have found their style somewhere amid the disco lights, taking inspiration from film classics of the 70's and 80's. Packed with funky arrangements straight from the dance-floor of Saturday Night Fever, these upbeat songs aren't just about going out and having fun. They also carry deeper messages about individual freedom, tolerance and cooperation.
